COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Competition for kindergarteners, children, cadets, youth, junior boys and girls, and adult men and women in Knock-Down kumite and kata.

1. Purpose of the Competition

- To promote Knock-Down and Full-Contact karate
- To expand opportunities for youth development and talent selection
- To strengthen friendships between Knock-Down and Full-Contact karate clubs

5. Competition Categories:

- Individual Knock-Down Kyokushin Karate Kumite
- Individual Kyokushin Karate Kata

6. Competition Rules:

According to the latest MFKSZ competition rule book, using round-robin or elimination system.



7. Kumite age groups, weight classes and minimum belt levels

Kindergarten: Born: 2020-2021, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: no weight classes
- Lányok: no weight classes

Children III.: Born: 2018-2019, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: -25 kg, -30 kg, -35 kg, +35 kg
- Girls: -20 kg, -25 kg, -30 kg, +30 kg

Children II.: Born: 2016-2017, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: -25 kg, -30 kg, -35 kg, +35 kg
- Girls: -25 kg, -30 kg, -35 kg, +35 kg

Children I.: Born: 2014-2015, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: -35 kg, -40 kg, -45 kg, -50 kg, +50 kg
- Girls: -30 kg, -35 kg, -40 kg, -45 kg, +45 kg

Cadet: Born: 2012-2013, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: -45 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg, -65 kg, +65 kg
- Girls: -45 kg, -55 kg, -65 kg, +65 kg

Youth: Born: 2010-2011, min. 10. kyu

- Boys: -55kg, -60 kg, -70 kg, -80 kg, +80 kg
- Girls: -50kg, -60 kg, +60 kg

Junior: Born: 2008-2009 and those born in 2007, who are continuing their high school studies but have not yet turned 19, min. 8th kyu

- Boys: -65 kg, -75 kg, -85 kg, +85 kg
- Girls: -55 kg, -65 kg, +65 kg

Adult „A” Category: Must be at least 18 years old as of January 1 of the following year, and hold at least a 4th kyu

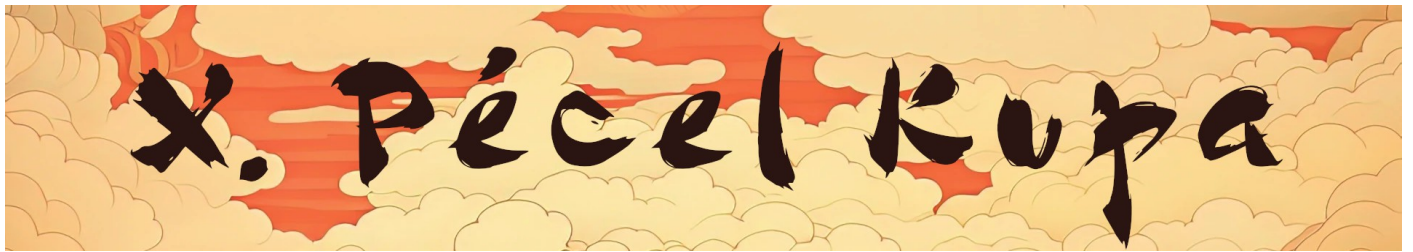
- Men: -70kg, -80kg, -90kg, + 90kg
- Women: -55kg, -65kg, +65kg

Referees: Referees are appointed by the Chief Referee



9. Protective Equipment

Competitors must bring their own protective equipment!

Kindergarten, Children, Cadet, Youth:

- Shin guards
- Cage headgear
- 3-finger gloves
- Groin guard for boys
- Basket chest protector for girls (must not cover the solar plexus)
- Mouthguard optional

Junior:

- Shin guards
- Cage headgear
- Groin guard (boys and girls)
- Chest protector for girls
- Mouthguard allowed

Adult category:

Women: chest protector, groin guard, mouthguard recommended

Men: groin guard, mouthguard recommended

10. Age Group Advancement:

Athletes move to the next age category on January 1 after reaching the required age:

Children III.	After turning 6.
Children II.	After turning 8.
Children I.	After turning 10.
Cadet	After turning 12.
Youth	After turning 14.
Junior	After turning 16.



KATA COMPETITION:

In the junior category, the competition follows a points-based system, while the children's, cadet, and youth categories use a flag-based elimination system.

- Valid sports medical clearance marked "*eligible to compete*"
- Belt rank entry and photo required
- Must attend on-site medical examination
- Correct belt rank for the age category
- Competitor must not be under suspension
- No head KO recorded within the last 6 months
